Resolution to Surrender Charter

WHEREAS, by letter dated February 28, 2016, the charter school application of Union Arts and Science Charter School (UASCS), serving the students of Linden and Elizabeth, was approved for a 2016-17 planning year with an opening in the 2017-18 school year;

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:11-2.1(h), the final granting of charter approval requires submission and approval by the Commissioner of Education of all documentation, including but not limited to a lease, mortgage or title to a facility and certificate of occupancy for "E" (education) use issued by a municipal enforcement official;

WHEREAS diligent efforts have been made by UASCS to obtain all documentation required for final charter approval, including a lease for a suitable facility and a certificate of occupancy; but a use variance determined to be necessary for operation of a charter school on the site selected for the school was denied by the Linden Zoning Board of Adjustment at a meeting on May 8, 2017;

WHEREAS, any appeal of the denial by the Linden Zoning Board of Adjustment, even if successful, would not be resolved within the time required for UASCS to begin operation in the 2017-18 school year;

WHEREAS, in light of the foregoing, the Lead Person, with regret, has recommended surrender of the charter;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The UASCS charter shall be and hereby is SURRENDERED, and the Lead Person is hereby authorized and directed to submit notice and any and all necessary and appropriate documentation to the Commissioner of Education to effect such SURRENDER of the UASCS charter; and
2. The Lead Person is hereby authorized and directed to taken any and all other necessary and appropriate action to wind up the affairs of UASCS, satisfy any and all obligations incurred on its behalf, and close any and all accounts held in its name.
